What: Shooting Investigation at 2 Iroquois Dr.

When: June 18, 2010

Where: City of Loveland, OH

LOVELAND, OH: On June 18, 2010 at approximately 4:23 p.m. Northeast Communications received a 911 telephone call indicating that two individuals had sustained gunshot wounds at 2 Iroquois Dr. Officers with the Loveland Police Division responded to the scene at approximately 4:25 p.m. Upon arrival Howard E. Williford Jr., age 53, and Debra S. West, age 49, were located at the residence with apparent gunshot wounds.

Mr. Williford was flown by medical helicopter to University Hospital with serious, but non-life threatening injuries. Ms. West was deceased upon the arrival of officers and paramedics with the Loveland Symmes Fire Department.

Detective K. Corbett in conjunction with the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation and Hamilton County Coroner's Office are investigating to determine that events surrounding the shooting. There are no additional persons of interest at this time.
